



## UNITED SPORTSMEN, INC. TRAP & SKEET RANGE

### RANGE RULES

#### General

1. No alcohol permitted anywhere except within the USI clubhouse and only after shooters have completed their day's shooting. Shooters having consumed alcohol will not be permitted to shoot that same day.
2. Eye and ear protection **required** for all shooters and observers inside the fence.
3. Keep gun actions open
  - Pump action and autoloaders must have actions open at all times except when gun is cased, or when shooter is on station.
  - Over-and-under or side-by-side gun actions must remain open except when guns are racked, cased, or when shooter is on station.
4. Carry guns to and from the skeet or trap fields, or between stations with muzzles pointed down or straight up. Never point gun at a person. Do not carry gun over shoulder so as to point muzzles towards others.
5. At the discretion of a squad leader, squads may contain six shooters.
6. While on station, guns may be loaded with two shells (for doubles).
7. Once on station, keep gun pointed down range at all times.
8. Before leaving a station, gun actions must be open and clear. **At no time may a shooter leave a station with a loaded gun.**
9. Only shells with shot size 9 are allowed on Fields # 2 and # 3. On Fields # 4, # 5, and #6, shot size 7 ½, 8, 8 ½, or 9 are allowed.

**Failure to adhere to these rules may be cause for denying members and guests access to USI shooting fields and facilities.**
